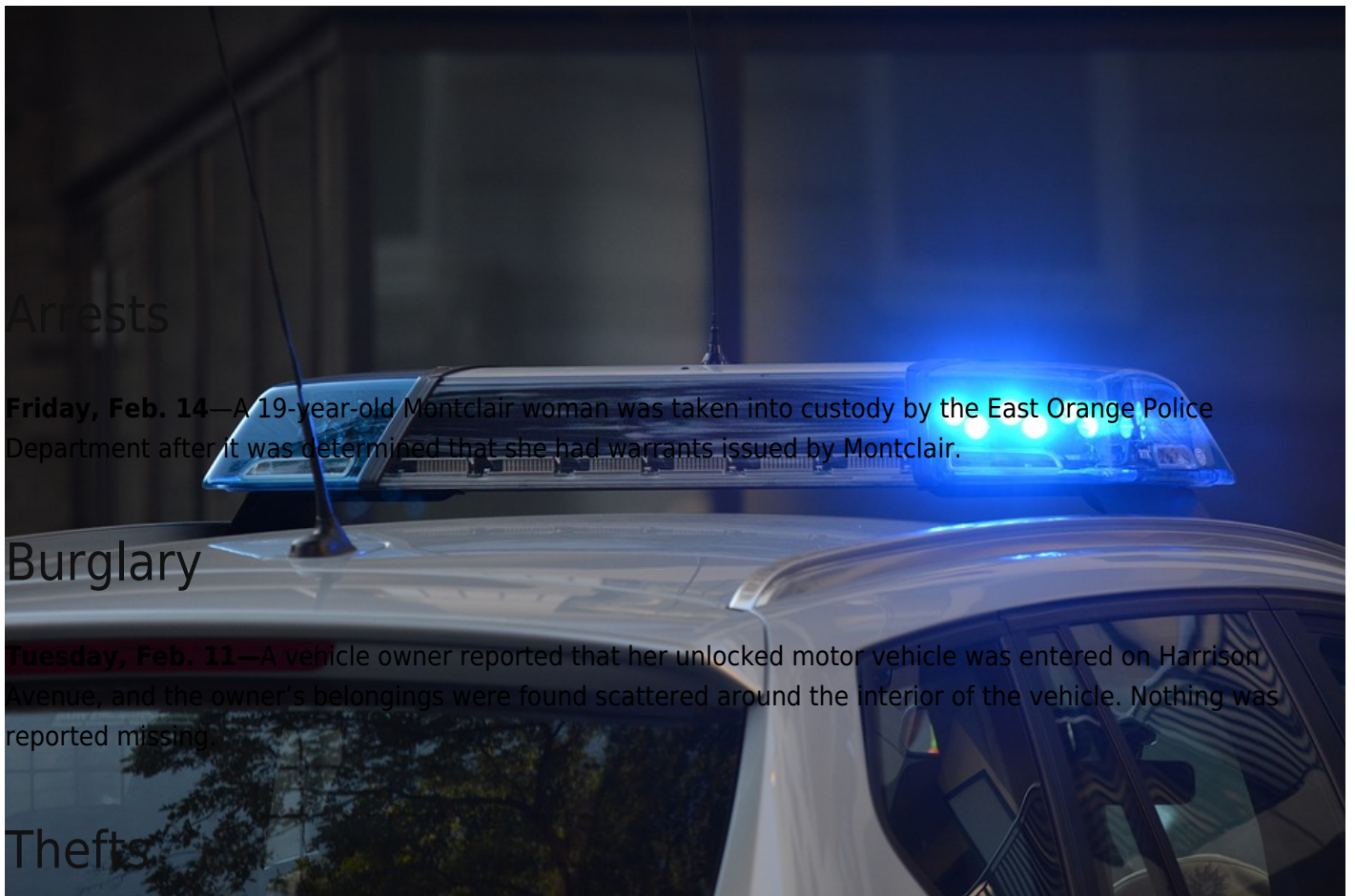




## Montclair Police Blotter: Feb. 18



## Arrests

**Friday, Feb. 14**—A 19-year-old Montclair woman was taken into custody by the East Orange Police Department after it was determined that she had warrants issued by Montclair.

## Burglary

**Tuesday, Feb. 11**—A vehicle owner reported that her unlocked motor vehicle was entered on Harrison Avenue, and the owner's belongings were found scattered around the interior of the vehicle. Nothing was reported missing.

**Sunday, Feb. 16**—A vehicle owner reported that over \$2,200 of property, mostly photo equipment, was stolen from his vehicle on Linden Avenue. The vehicle may have been left unlocked prior to the theft.
